90si User's Guide Changes

The following 90si User's Guide sections, 3.2 and 3.3, have been modified specifically for the MB491. All other sections of the 90si User's Guide remain unchanged.

3.2 Sending a Secure Fax

- 1. Place a call on your Secure Telephone (STE, OMNI, vIPer, SWT, etc.).
- 2. Place your Secure Telephone in Secure Data Mode.
- 3. Insure that the "Fax/Hook" button is illuminated blue. If not, press it and load your document on the MB491 face up.
- 4. Press "Fax/Hook" then "1" on the dial pad and then the gray "Mono Start" button.
- 5. Standby while the document is transmitted. The fax will beep when it is done indicating that it is OK to return to secure-voice mode, clear-voice mode or terminate the call.

3.3 Receiving a Secure Fax

- 1. Answer your Secure Telephone (STE, OMNI, vIPer, SWT, etc.).
- 2. Place your Secure Telephone in Secure Data mode. The sender usually does this.
- 3. Standby, the fax will be received automatically. The fax will beep when it is done indicating that it is OK to return to secure-voice mode, clear-voice mode or terminate the call.

Memory

The Okidata MB491 comes factory-modified with dynamic (volatile) facsimile image memory. This means that turning off the power to the fax will cause any fax data in image memory to be removed. This MB491 is not the commercial version, it has been modified especially for us to insure that fax memory is volatile. The manual that comes with the unit, however, has not been modified and therefore some functions described therein may no longer work as described. The MB491 power switch is on the front of the fax in the lower right corner. In addition, the 90si Secure Fax Gateway was specifically designed as a secure fax product and as such, does not retain any image data.
